The children stayed at the Old Pheasantry at Mogador and arrived to a welcome meal provided by Twinning. The following day they met their friends at school at a special ceremony to mark the tenth anniversary, which is the youngest exchange in the UK. Our Mayor, Penelope and myself were there to offer congratulations to both sets of pupils and teachers and thanks to Hartmut Froehlich, Ute Peter and Ollie Moses Priory's Headteacher. The children spent the week together in school learning and working on joint projects, and then enjoyed a day together in Brighton and trip to Sea Life sponsored by Twinning.
